## **Red Flags**

Stalking – repeated following, harassment, or other unwanted communication Isolation – limiting who someone can hang out with

Coercion – using emotional pressure or physical threats to engage in sexual acts
Sexual Assault – pressuring or forcing someone into sexual activity against
his/her will

Emotional Abuse – put-downs, name-calling, and other degrading comments

Jealousy – all-consuming possessiveness or suspicion

Victim Blaming – treating someone poorly and then blaming them for it
